- Maintaining currency as applicable to Conair Aerostudies, Maintenance Bulletins and notices;
- Knowledge of CAR's regulations as related to aircraft maintenance;
- Understanding the flow and processes involved in the information technologies.

- Knowledge of government laws, safety rules, regulations and safe practices;
- Knowledge of aircraft parts and theory of aircraft structures;
- Ability to learn new skills quickly and respond to verbal instructions;
